We have continued to fund Marking courses – Two this year with 19 attendees- 9 juniors with 4 taking the exam and practical to obtain their "C" grade England Squash Accreditation- Adam Kula, Brad Jenkins, Devin Walsh and Will Rogers-Tizard. Also Ex Junior Chris Kula gained the "C" grade. Support has also been given to Avon Squash – part sponsorship of a coach's course.

Committee Proposal : A proposal was put forward regarding rule 15 – requiring the need to have played at least three times be amended to twice at least prior to playoffs. Rationale was discussed and unanimously by the room.
